Introduction

The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) also known as the Global Goals were established by the United Nations in 2015 and adopted by 195 countries worldwide as a universal call to action to end poverty, protect the planet, and ensure peace and prosperity for all by 2030. These 17 goals, with 169 specific targets, aim to create a more inclusive, equitable, and sustainable world.

Pakistan has demonstrated a strong and sustained commitment to the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, being one of the first countries to adopt the SDGs globally in 2015. On 16th February 2016, the Parliament of Pakistan unanimously approved the SDGs as the national development agenda, and subsequently established the Parliamentary SDGs Secretariat one of the few such institutional frameworks in the world

This legislative milestone marked a crucial step in mainstreaming and localizing the SDGs within Pakistan's national and provincial development strategies. The localization process has emphasized evidence-based policymaking, stakeholder inclusion, and the translation of global targets into context-specific, actionable objectives for federal, provincial, and local actors.

Following the 18th Constitutional Amendment, which devolved key social and developmental responsibilities to the provinces, Pakistan strengthened its coordination mechanisms between federal and provincial governments to advance the SDG agenda. The country continues to promote integrated planning, data-driven monitoring, and multi-stakeholder partnerships to ensure measurable progress on each goal. In alignment with the UN 2025 SDG Progress Framework, Pakistan's approach increasingly focuses on digital innovation, climate resilience, social protection systems, gender equality, and inclusive economic growth. The Vision 2025 framework remains fully aligned with the SDGs, providing a long-term roadmap for inclusive, sustainable, and resilient national development.

The distribution of research topics is as follows:


- **SDG 3: Good Health and Well-Being** 33 publications

Community Services





Emergency Response & Safety Equipment

- Evacuation plans
- safety signage

- Specialized equipment including fire blankets, fire balls, glass breakers, and safety torches to support emergency handling.


Waste Management








SDG13-ClimateAction
